

WHAT IS A COOKIE

Cookies are small text files that are stored on your computer or mobile device. They are widely used in order to make websites work, or work in a better, more efficient way. They can do this because websites can read and write these files, enabling them to recognise you and remember important information that will make your use of a website more convenient (for example by remembering preference settings).

WHAT COOKIES DO WE USE?

Below we list the different types of cookies that may be used on the Site. Note that to the extent information collected through cookies constitutes personal information, the provisions in the **Privacy Policy** apply and complement this Cookie Policy.

Essential Cookies. Essential cookies are necessary for the Site to work and enable you to move around it and to use its services and features. Without these absolutely necessary cookies, the Site will not perform as smoothly for you as we would like it to and we may not be able to provide the Site or certain services or features you request.

COOKIE TYPE	DESCRIPTION	HOW TO MANAGE COOKIES
Session	Session cookies are used to maintain the state of the application.	Accept/refuse via browser setting
Load balancing	Load balancing cookies are used to distribute the assets across the globe and lighten the server load.	Accept/refuse via browser setting
User ID	User ID cookies are used to ensure that users only see their own information.	Accept/refuse via browser setting
Security	Security cookies are used for security controls and checks.	Accept/refuse via browser setting

Social Plug-in Tracking Cookies. Such cookies are used to track members [and non-members] of social media networks for market research analytics, and product development.

Facebook Pixel	<p>This Cookie is placed by Facebook. It enables FREELANCE CORNER to measure, optimize and build audiences for advertising campaigns served on Facebook. In particular it enables FREELANCE CORNER to see how our users move between devices when accessing the FREELANCE CORNER web site and Facebook, to ensure that FREELANCE CORNER's Facebook advertising is seen by our users most likely to be interested in such advertising by analysing which content a user has viewed and interacted with on the FREELANCE CORNER web site. Twitter Conversion Tracker	<p>This Cookie is placed by Twitter. It enables FREELANCE CORNER to learn how our users have interacted with FREELANCE CORNER advertising served to them on Twitter. Analytics Cookies. Analytics cookies collect information about your use of the Site and enable us to improve the way it works. For example, analytics cookies show us which are the most frequently visited pages on the Site, help us record any difficulties you have with the Site, and show us whether our advertising is effective or not. This allows us to see the overall patterns of usage on the Site, rather than the usage of a single person.

Google analytics	Google analytics cookies collect aggregate statistical data to improve Site presentation and navigation. Hotjar	When someone visits Freelance Corner.co.uk, we collect standard internet log information and details of visitor behaviour patterns. We do this to find out things such as the number of visitors to the various parts of the site. We collect this information in a way which does not personally identify anyone. Google Remarketing	This website uses the Google AdWords remarketing service to advertise on third party websites (including Google) to previous visitors to our site. It could mean that we advertise to previous visitors who haven't completed a task on our site, for example using the contact form to make an enquiry. This could be in the form of an advertisement on the Google search results page, or a site in the Google Display Network.
