

EIT Heath Alumni Network Platform Terms of Use

These Terms of Use ("<u>Terms of Use</u>") are effective as of 29 November 2019. By accessing or using the Community Website (the "<u>Service</u>"), or by logging into the site with your allocated User ID, you agree to be bound by these Terms of Use. The Service is owned and operated by EIT Health, acting by and through the EIT Health Alumni Network

Please review these Terms of Use carefully prior to using the Service. If you do not agree with these Terms of Use, please do not use the Service.

The Service comprises a suite of online services provided by EIT Health including but not limited to:

- an online EIT Health Alumni Community Directory
- the Community Messaging Service class emailer,
- a User-to-User Community Messaging service, and

These Terms of Use govern your use of each component of the Service.



1. Copyright; Rules for Submission of Content.

- (a) The Service and any data, text, files, information, usernames, images, graphics, photos, profiles, audio and video clips, sounds, works of authorship, applications, links, and other content or materials (collectively, the "Service Content") are protected by copyright, trademark and other laws. As between you and EIT Health. EIT Health owns the intellectual property rights in the Service and the Service Content. You may use the Service and the Service Content only in the manner and for the purposes specified in these Terms of Use. Except as specifically permitted by these Terms of Use, you may not modify, transmit, produce, distribute, display, sell, license, broadcast, or otherwise make available in any form or by any means any part of the Service or the Service Content without the express written permission of EIT Health.
- (b) You retain ownership of all of your intellectual property rights in any content created, posted, or shared by you, on or through the Service and any personal data, (the "<u>User Content</u>"). EIT Health does not claim ownership of your User Content.
- (c) You represent and warrant that: (i) you own your User Content; (ii) the posting and use of your User Content on or through the Service will not violate, misappropriate or infringe on the rights of any third party, including, without limitation, privacy rights, publicity rights, copyrights, trademark and/or other intellectual property rights; (iii) you shall pay for all royalties, fees, and any other monies owed by reason of your User Content; and (iv) you have the legal right and capacity to enter into these Terms of Use in your jurisdiction.

User accounts may not be shared, transferred, or sold to other parties, nor are they to be used by or made available to any person or entity except the registered user.

EITHealthAlumni App End User License Agreement

This End User License Agreement ("Agreement") is between you and EITHealthAlumni and governs use of this app made available through the Apple App Store. By installing the EITHealthAlumni App, you agree to be bound by this Agreement and understand that there is no tolerance for objectionable content. If you do not agree with the terms and conditions of this Agreement, you are not entitled to use the EITHealthAlumni App.

In order to ensure EITHealthAlumni provides the best experience possible for everyone, we strongly enforce a no tolerance policy for objectionable content. If you see inappropriate content, please use the "Report as offensive" feature found under each post.

1. Parties

This Agreement is between you and EITHealthAlumni only, and not Apple, Inc. ("Apple"). Notwithstanding the foregoing, you acknowledge that Apple and its subsidiaries are third party beneficiaries of this Agreement and Apple has the right to enforce this Agreement against you. EITHealthAlumni, not Apple, is solely responsible for the EITHealthAlumni App and its content.

2. Privacy

EITHealthAlumni may collect and use information about your usage of the EITHealthAlumni App, including certain types of information from and about your device. EITHealthAlumni may use this information, as long as it is in a form that does not personally identify you, to measure the use and performance of the EITHealthAlumni App.

3. Limited License

EITHealthAlumni grants you a limited, non-exclusive, non-transferable, revocable license to use the EITHealthAlumni App for your personal, non-commercial purposes. You may only use the EITHealthAlumni App on Apple devices that you own or control and as permitted by the App Store Terms of Service.

4. Age Restrictions

By using the EITHealthAlumni App, you represent and warrant that (a) you are 17 years of age or older and you agree to be bound by this Agreement; (b) if you are under 17 years of age, you have obtained verifiable consent from a parent or legal guardian; and (c) your use of the EITHealthAlumni App does not violate any applicable law or regulation. Your access to the EITHealthAlumni App may be terminated without warning if EITHealthAlumni believes, in its sole discretion, that you are under the age of 17 years and have not obtained verifiable consent from a parent or legal guardian. If you are a parent or legal guardian and you provide your consent to your child's use of the EITHealthAlumni App, you agree to be bound by this Agreement in respect to your child's use of the EITHealthAlumni App.

5. Objectionable Content Policy

Content may not be submitted to EITHealthAlumni, who will moderate all content and ultimately decide whether or not to post a submission to the extent such content includes, is in conjunction with, or



alongside any, Objectionable Content. EITHealthAlumni does provide minimal maintenance or support for it but not to the extent that any maintenance or support is required by applicable law, EITHealthAlumni, not Apple, shall be obligated to furnish any such maintenance or support.

8. Product Claims

EITHealthAlumni, not Apple, is responsible for addressing any claims by you relating to the EITHealthAlumni App or use of it, including, but not limited to: (i) any product liability claim; (ii) any claim that the EITHealthAlumni App fails to conform to any applicable legal or regulatory requirement; and (iii) any claim arising under consumer protection or similar legislation. Nothing in this Agreement shall be deemed an admission that you may have such claims.

9. Third Party Intellectual Property Claims

EITHealthAlumni shall not be obligated to indemnify or defend you with respect to any third party claim arising out or relating to the EITHealthAlumni App. To the extent EITHealthAlumni is required to provide indemnification by applicable law, EITHealthAlumni, not Apple, shall be solely responsible for the investigation, defense, settlement and discharge of any claim that the EITHealthAlumni App or your use of it infringes any third party intellectual property right.
