## Become the Business Analyst






### How it works

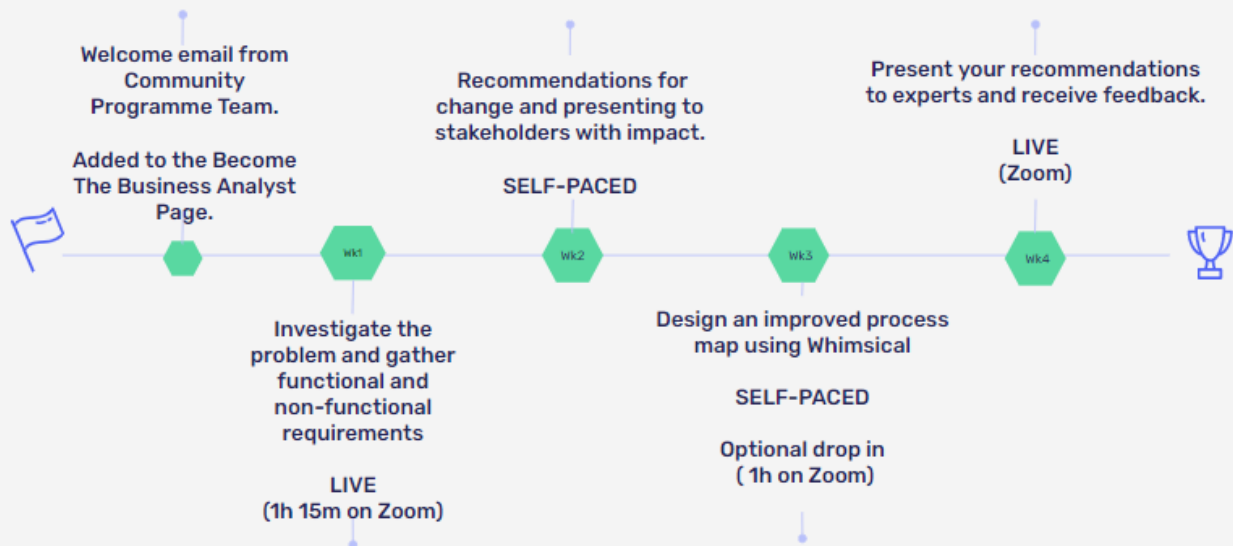
There will be two live sessions, some self-paced learning and time for you to work in your teams. You will be expected to dedicate 2.5 hours a week to the project.
