The aim of the Online Community is for these people and groups to share what they are doing with everyone else, in order to inspire each other, share advice and resources, and to make new connections.

You are welcome to start discussions, share events as long as they are relevant to the scope of Egin and free to join, and reach out to people for collaboration.

The following types of posts are not permitted:

- 1) Anything that is offensive, derogatory, inflammatory or abusive (these are already laid out in the Terms of Use) towards any individual or group of people; this includes harassment or discrimination of any kind.
- 2) The promotion of any illegal activity;
- 3) The promotion of any paid events – you are welcome to share about free or donation-based events (as long as free entry is also permitted);
- 4) Posts relating to lobbying, including the sharing of petitions;
- 5) Posts considered to be “spam” in nature. -e.g. excessive posting about the same thing, trying to advertise one’s own products or services, recruit others to a group or cause - either publicly or in someone’s direct message inbox. This is a little harder to quantify; each case will be considered individually by the administration team.

In the case of receiving “spam” into one’s direct messages, please notify the administrators so we can look into it.

The administration reserves the right to remove any posts that contravene these rules, as well as others that may have been reported once we have investigated. In repeat cases that continue after we have given a warning, we reserve the right to remove individuals from the Egin Online Community.

Privacy:

Please note that anything you share on the Egin online Community will be visible to other members, including what you add to your profile. The email address you used to sign up is not visible.

At any time, click your photo/initials on the top right and My Settings > Privacy to change settings about who can view your profile and send you messages. You can also choose to

make your email address, phone number or address visible to everyone if you want to - but the default is visible only to admin.
