



Dear EANS members,

The call for Fellowship of the European Academy of Nursing Science (FEANS) is open from February 1st to March 31th 2026.

Requirements to become FEANS

Fellows of the European Academy of Nursing Science (EANS) are active Full Members of the Academy with evidence of reliable and special contribution to EANS work and European Nursing Scholarship. Fellows are renowned nursing scientists with high reputation, have an active European residency at the time of the Fellowship application, have a considerable scientific record and have demonstrated their scientific impact in the field of nursing research. Besides, FEANS have societal impact in the field of nursing at a national and/or European/international level.

Your application to become FEANS should include:

1. **A short CV (max 2 pages)** highlighting your educational background including the date of your PhD defense, working experience, current positions and an overview of your engagement within the EANS community in the past years (e.g. as student, member, committee member, board member, event organizer, contributions to the summer school, webinars – including dates)
2. **Evidence of at least 10 original articles** (including systematic reviews) related to nursing, as first/second/last/senior author published in international peer-reviewed journals after obtaining the PhD degree and available in international databases (e.g. PubMed, Embase, Web of Science, CINAHL). Include a list of the articles you submit for consideration, and for each article, provide a link to the database where the article can be retrieved.
3. A 400-word narrative where you argue the **scientific impact of your research work** (e.g. How did your work contribute to addressing knowledge gaps in your field? How did you contribute to theory building in your field?).
4. A 400-word narrative where you argue the **societal impact of your academic work** (e.g. public contributions to enhance visibility of nursing science/your work to civic groups, interviews, political activities, membership of advisory boards, clinical leadership roles or educational roles).
5. **Two letters of recommendation from current FEANS** who endorse your advancement to fellowship status. This letter should comprise a reflection about your contribution to the EANS Society and your impact to the development of nursing science, education and/or practice in your country of origin and Europe.
6. A **letter** where you **agree to attend the next EANS meeting** where the fellowship status will be officially awarded if your application is accepted. This year, the announcement will be made during the gala dinner on **9 July 2026** in **St. Gallen, Switzerland**.

Candidates are invited to apply for EANS fellowship by sending their application as 1 PDF-file to marco.clari@unito.it.

Fellowship applications will be reviewed by the EANS Membership Committee and final decisions will be taken by the EANS Executive Board.
