The [Global Consortium on Climate and Health Education \(GCCHE\)](#) at Columbia University and the [Global Nurses Working Group \(GNWG\)](#), in collaboration with international partners, invite you and your institution to take part in a global survey on the integration of climate and planetary health in nursing curricula, conducted for the [Lancet Countdown on Health and Climate Change](#).

This study has been approved by the Columbia University Institutional Review Board (protocol #AAAU7307). Participation is voluntary, and all responses will remain confidential and anonymous. Data will be securely stored, analyzed by the Global Consortium on Climate and Health Education (GCCHE), and anonymized prior to reporting.

Your participation is vital, even if your institution DOES NOT currently offer climate and health education.

This survey seeks to understand current teaching efforts related to climate and planetary health in nursing education, with the goal of strengthening the future of nursing practice and academic leadership in this area.

The survey takes approximately 5–15 minutes to complete and will contribute to a new *Lancet Countdown* indicator assessing how nursing programs worldwide are preparing future nurses to address the health impacts of climate change.
