SCENARIO

McMinnville School District operated its multiple communication and safety systems—access control, phones, intercoms, and more—independently, and this was a big problem. When the district needed to send notifications to students and faculty within their buildings, office personnel had to determine which system to use and in which order. This made for inefficient communications during emergency and non-emergency events.

The district needed a way to unify its disparate systems and streamline its communication processes, through a solution that could both deliver district-wide alerts and drill down to the individual school building and classroom level.
